Day 1 - Sep 14 (Fri) Depart USA

Depart the USA for overnight flight to Paris.

Day 2 - Sep 15 (Sat) Arrive Paris

Tucked away in the Impasse Berthaud near the colorful Centre Pompidou is the diminutive Musée de la Poupée. More than five hundred stunning French dolls, dating from 1800 to the present, are cleverly displayed in vignettes containing doll furniture, doll accessories, and toys. Toys from the Middle Ages to the present day are the focus of our attention at the Musée des Arts Décoratifs, where furniture, wallpaper, tapestries, ceramics, glassware, and other objets d'arts are also exhibited. (*Hotel Duquesne Eiffel, Paris, 4 nights*)

Day 3 - Sep 16 (Sun) Paris Flea Markets

It's all-day shopping at the Puces de St-Ouen! With a seemingly inexhaustible supply of vendors — as many as 3,000 of them — it is one of the largest collectibles markets in the world. The high quality of the items to be found here defies the term "flea market." We will show you the best places to shop for dolls and toys. (*Buffet Breakfast*)

Day 4 - Sep 17 (Mon) Paris Shopping & Leisure

You have the whole day free to shop, see the sights, or visit a museum at your leisure. The Louvre is open today. If you're looking for something a little different, check out the Musée du Parfum, exhibiting an exquisite collection of perfume bottles from the 17th through the 20th centuries. (*Buffet Breakfast*)

Day 5 - Sep 18 (Tue) Monet's Garden at Giverny

Our day trip to Giverny brings us to Le Maison et Jardin Claude-Monet. The house, with its pretty pink walls and green shutters, has been lovingly restored to Monet's original designs and is open to visitors. Stroll through flower-laden gardens to the famous Japanese bridge and water-lily pond, which appear in many of Monet's paintings. (*Buffet Breakfast*)

Day 6 - Sep 19 (Wed) Beaune & Pérouges

We stop in Beaune on our way to Pérouges. Beaune is the capital of the Burgundy Wine Country and one of the best-preserved medieval cities in the district. The town is best known for the Hôtel Dieu with its splendid roof of multi-colored geometric tiles. Pérouges is perhaps the most picturesque medieval stone village in Burgundy and our home for the next three nights. (*Buffet Breakfast*) (*Ostellerie, Vieux Pérouges, 3 nights*)

Day 7 - Sep 20 (Thu) Lyon

Devoted exclusively to cloth and fashion, the Musée des Tissus gives particular attention to the history of silk from the Renaissance to the present. Observe the "pochoir" technique of silk printing, and see how the figured relief is painted entirely by hand on silk mousseline at L'Atelier de Soierie. Shop for couturier fabrics and Lyon silk. (*Continental Breakfast*)

Day 8 - Sep 21 (Fri) Chazelles sur Lyon & Marcy l'Etoile

The Musée du Chapeau not only exhibits an exceptional collection of hats from the 18th century to the present, but documents, with a video and live demonstrations, the process of transforming rabbit fur into luxury hats. Le Château de la Poupée shelters a stunning collection of French and German dolls. (*Continental Breakfast*)

Day 9 - Sep 22 (Sat) Luzern

Luzern's picturesque Old Town straddles the narrowed waters where the River Reuss flows out of Lake Luzern. There's plenty of sightseeing and shopping here! (*Continental Breakfast*) (*Hotel Seeburg, Luzern, 3 nights*)

Day 10 - Sep 23 (Sun) Mt. Pilatus & Zürich

Ascend 7,000 feet on the steepest cog railway in the world to the summit of Mt. Pilatus for the best 360-degree panorama of the Alps in Switzerland. Throw snowballs, warm up with a cappuccino, and admire the fabulous views to the "sounds of the mountain" — Alpenhorns blown by the Pilatusbläser. We descend the mountain by aerial cable way in panoramic gondolas. Sasha lovers can visit the Sasha Morgenthaler Puppenmuseum in Zürich this afternoon. (*Buffet Breakfast*)

Day 11 - Sep 24 (Mon) Luzern Shopping & Leisure

You have the whole day free to shop, see the sights, or visit a museum at your leisure. We know a nice place to shop for antique dolls, dolls' houses, and dolls' accessories, and we'll take you there. (*Buffet Breakfast*)

Day 12 - Sep 25 (Tue) Basel & Colmar

The four-story Puppenhausmuseum offers an especially unique exhibition of dolls, toys, and teddy bears. Thousands of objects are cleverly arranged in themed displays that captivate, charm, and amuse. Colmar is the most beautiful city of Alsace — calm canals and rows of rainbow-colored, half-timbered houses invite an evening stroll after dinner at a sidewalk café. (*Buffet Breakfast*) (*Hotel Le Rapp, Colmar, 3 nights*)

Day 13 - Sep 26 (Wed) Illkirch & Betschdorf

The Marquise de Sévigné invites you to share her passion for chocolate in a unique museum — Les Secrets du Chocolat — devoted entirely to cocoa and its transformation into exquisite, delicious chocolate. The main thoroughfare of Betschdorf, the Town of Potters, is lined with the most charming 18th-century, half-timbered houses. Begin your visit at the Musée de la Poterie. Then visit some of the dozen potteries where you can buy the famous grey-and-blue, salt-glazed stoneware. (*Buffet Breakfast*)

Day 14 - Sep 27 (Thu) Colmar Shopping & Leisure

You have the whole day free to shop, see the sights, or visit a museum at your leisure, such as the little Musée Animé du Jouet. (*Buffet Breakfast*)

Day 15 - Sep 28 (Fri) Trier

The history of Trier begins around the middle of the 1st century BC when Gaius Julius Caesar conquered Gaul and integrated the Mosel region into the Roman Empire. It is Germany's oldest city, the home of Roman emperors. We begin our visit at the Spielzeugmuseum in the beautiful Hauptmarkt. The rest of the day is free for shopping. (*Buffet Breakfast*) (*Hotel Römischer Kaiser, Trier, 3 nights*)

Day 16 - Sep 29 (Sat) Trier Sightseeing

Our tour of ancient Trier includes the Porta Nigra, the Roman Basilica, the Imperial Baths, and other sites of antiquity. (*Champagne Buffet Breakfast*)

Day 17 - Sep 30 (Sun) Constantine Exhibition

The city of Trier is staging one of the most important cultural and historical exhibitions of 2007 — "Constantine the Great" — and we're here to see it! Treasured exhibits from internationally renowned museums such as the Louvre in Paris, the Capitoline Museums in Rome, the Vatican, and the British Museum in London, will be displayed with finds from ancient Trier made public for the very first time. The exhibit is presented in three venues — the Rheinisches Landesmuseum, the Bischöfliches Dom- und Diözesanmuseum, and the Städtisches Museum Simeonstift — and includes such highlights as the head of the colossal statue of Emperor Constantine, exquisite natural stone tesserae floors, and the breathtaking Constantine ceiling frescoes. (*Champagne Buffet Breakfast and "Auf Wiedersehen" Dinner*)

Day 18 - Oct 1 (Mon) Frankfurt

What's Not Included in the Tour Price

Passport fees, insurance of all kinds, laundry, phone calls, meals and beverages not detailed in the itinerary, tip for the tour bus driver, items of a personal nature, portorage, excess baggage charges, independent excursions, etc. The tour price also does not cover costs and expenses, including the return to your home, if you

leave the tour, either of your own volition or at our request, or due to illness, or as a consequence of official action by the government of any country visited.

General Information & Conditions

- **Tour Price** is based on a minimum of 10 passengers and costs, charges, tariffs, rates, prices, taxes, levies, and exchange rates as at 4 September 2006. Should any of these costs change, a surcharge *may* be made on the price of your tour. If the total tour price increases by more than 5%, passengers will have the right to cancel within 7 days of notification of the surcharge, without penalty.
- **Airport Transfers:** Coach transfers will run from Paris CDG Airport to the Hotel Bastille at 13:00 on 15 September 2007, and from the Hotel Römischer Kaiser to Frankfurt Airport at 9:00 on 1 October 2007. Passengers will receive coach transfers at the aforementioned times at no additional charge. However, Passengers arriving or departing outside the aforementioned coach transfer times must make their own arrangements at their own expense.
- **Tour Participation:** The tour is moderately strenuous. There is a considerable amount of walking on both level and hilly terrain, stairs to climb, and many cobbled walkways and streets to negotiate. Passengers requiring any special assistance must be accompanied at all times by an able-bodied companion to provide such assistance. Puppentour™ reserves the right in its absolute discretion to refuse to carry any person whose conduct or manner causes disruption of the tour or offense or upset to other passengers. In such cases full cancellation charges will apply and Puppentour™ shall have no further liability for that passenger.
- **Itinerary Variations:** Puppentour™ constantly strives to improve tour itineraries and features. If such improvements can be made, or unforeseen circumstances beyond our control make changes necessary, we reserve the right to vary itineraries, change airlines, and substitute hotels, with or without notice.
- **Tour Cancellation:** Puppentour™ reserves the right to cancel or re-schedule tour departure in accordance with operating requirements or circumstances beyond its control. If cancellation is made any time prior to departure, Puppentour's™ only liability will be to refund to the passenger the amount it has received for the tour booking. Puppentour™ is not responsible for any other travel arrangements affected due to our cancellations.

- **Airline seating:** Puppentour™ will request your preferred seating; however, seating is solely under the control of the airline.

- **Extended stays:** If you do not fly with the group and/or have arranged to depart earlier or stay later than the scheduled tour dates, your expenses – food, lodging, transfers to join the tour or to the airport for your return

flight, etc. – will be at your sole expense.

- **Delayed or cancelled flights:** Lodging, meals, and other traveling expenses occasioned by flight delays or cancellations are your sole responsibility.

Reservations & Final Payment

1. A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure your reservation. Reservations are first-come, first-served and are limited to 15 passengers.
2. The balance of your tour payment is due by 11 June 2007, or immediately upon booking your tour after 11 June 2007.
3. All costs are quoted and payable in US dollars.
4. Please make checks and money orders payable to Puppentour™. At a 3% premium, we also accept credit cards through PayPal™ (inquire for details). Your payment is not deemed made until it is received by Puppentour™.
5. Puppentour™ reserves the right to cancel the reservation and impose cancellation charges should payments not be received within the above specified periods.

Travel Documents

Travel documents, including itinerary, luggage tags, and name tag, will be sent to you approximately fourteen (14) days before departure, providing full payment has been received.

Cancellation Fees

Cancellations are not effective until they are received in writing by Puppentour™. If you cancel and we receive your written cancellation ninety-five (95) days or more prior to departure, a full refund less your per person \$500 deposit will be made. For written cancellations received less than ninety-five (95) days prior to departure, the following per person cancellation fees will apply:

- 94 to 60 days - the fee is 25% of the applicable gross tour price.
- 59 to 45 days - the fee is 50% of the applicable gross tour price.
- 44 to 30 days - the fee is 75% of the applicable gross tour price.
- 29 days or less prior, or for non-appearance, the cancellation fee is 100% of the applicable gross tour price.

The cancellation fees are due regardless of resale. These fees cannot be applied to future bookings. Tour contracts are not transferable.

We strongly recommend, for your protection, that you purchase trip cancellation insurance coverage.

Trip Cancellation & Interruption Protection

At an additional cost, we offer a 24-hour, worldwide travel protection plan – Global Alert!® – that provides excellent coverage and a waiver of pre-existing conditions if you purchase the policy within fifteen (15) days of making your initial tour deposit. The insurer pays you the insured amount

of the tour cost for any financial loss you incur if you must cancel any time before the trip or prior to your return due to illness, injury, or death of yourself, a family member, or traveling companion. Certain exclusions apply. **Puppentour™ must receive a photocopy of your travel insurance certificate, or a signed waiver of travel insurance coverage, by 15 August 2007.**

Responsibility

1. Puppentour™ shall be responsible to the passenger for supplying the services and accommodations described in the accompanying brochure, except where such services cannot be supplied or the itinerary used is changed due to delays or other causes of whatever kind or nature beyond the control of Puppentour™. In such circumstances, Puppentour™ will do its best to supply comparable services, accommodations, and itineraries, with or without notice, and there shall be no refund in this connection.

2. This brochure represents the entire agreement between the passenger and Puppentour™.

3. In the absence of their own negligence, neither Puppentour™ nor any cooperating organizations shall be responsible for any cancellations or for acts of any other service providers concerned, diversions or substitution of equipment, variations, postponements, omission or default whatsoever by air carriers, land carriers, hoteliers or hotels, transportation companies, or any other persons providing any of the services and accommodations to passengers including any results thereof, such as changes in services, accommodations or facilities necessitated by same; nor shall they be liable for any loss or damage to baggage or property, or for injury, illness or death, or for any damages or claims whatsoever arising from loss, negligence or delay from the act, error, omission, default, or negligence of any person not its direct employee or under its exclusive control, including any act, error, omission, default, or negligence of any country, government or governmental authority, officer or employee. **All baggage and personal effects are at all times and in all circumstances at the risk of the tour participant. Baggage insurance is recommended.** The carriers, hotels and other suppliers who provide services on tour are independent contractors; they are not agents, employees or servants of Puppentour™ or our associated companies. Puppentour™ is not responsible for any criminal conduct by third parties.

4. Where the passenger occupies a tour bus seat fitted with a safety belt, neither Puppentour™ nor co-operating organizations or service providers concerned will be liable for any injury, illness or death or for any loss or damages or claims whatsoever arising from any accident or incident, if the safety belt is not being worn at the time of such accident or incident.

5. Transportation companies, airlines, etc. are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time passengers are not on board planes, transportation or conveyances. The passenger contracts in use by the airlines or transportation companies when used shall constitute the sole contract between the airline, transportation company and passenger or purchaser of this tour and Puppentour™ assumes no responsibility in this connection. Enrollment in and payment for the tour shall constitute agreement and acceptance by the passenger of the terms and conditions set forth in this brochure which cannot be varied except in writing by an officer of Puppentour™.

6. The agreement arising between the purchaser and passenger and Puppentour™ under these terms and conditions, and the booking made by the purchaser and passenger shall be governed by the law of the State of Arizona, which shall have exclusive jurisdiction in the case of any dispute between the parties.

7. In the case of computer or human billing error we reserve the right to re-invoice with corrected billings.

8. Every effort is made to ensure brochure accuracy at the time of going to press; however, Puppentour™ cannot be held responsible for printing or typographical errors, or errors arising from unforeseen circumstances.

9. The invalidity of any of the provisions hereof shall not affect the validity of any of the other provisions, and the agreements shall be construed as though such invalid provision had never been contained herein.

Other Conditions

Things to Know Before You Go

- **Passports:** US citizens need only a valid passport to enter France, Switzerland, and Germany for visits

of less than three months. On request, Puppentour™ will supply US citizens with information on how to obtain a US passport or renew an expired US passport. **Puppentour™ must receive a photocopy of your valid passport by 15 August 2007.**

- **Baggage Restrictions:** Each passenger is allowed two pieces of luggage. One may not exceed 62 inches (length plus width plus height) and a maximum packed weight of 50 pounds; and the other may not exceed 50 inches (length plus width plus height) and a maximum packed weight of 40 pounds. You may pack an empty collapsible third bag in one of your suitcases in which to pack your souvenirs. Puppentour™ luggage tags will be supplied to you prior to departure and must be attached to your luggage.

- **Electricity:** The voltage in Europe is 220/240. Take only dual voltage appliances with you and purchase the appropriate outlet adapters. Don't bother with transformers or converters – they seldom operate properly.

- **Air Conditioning:** Foreign air conditioning systems are not always up to US standards.

- **Twin share:** European twin beds are generally placed directly next to each other with no space between them. The beds do have separate mattresses and bed linens, however.
